

6 held cutting WASA pipe

ST JOSEPH police held six men for questioning after they were held cutting a 21-inch length of pipeline owned by WASA.

The six accused were apprehended by a party of officers, led by PC Rodney, on Thursday. The pipe was recovered at Caiman Road, St Joseph. Charges were expected to be laid against the six accused yesterday.

This follows Wednesday's arrest and

charge of Antonio Singh of Gasparillo for larceny of two lengths of 20-inch ductile iron pipes from WASA.

WASA said investigations were underway to determine whether the pipe recovered at St Joseph, was connected to Monday's theft of steel pipes and metal fittings (including an eight-inch air valve from a section of the 54-inch Caroni South Transmission Main, at Perseverance Village, Chaguanas.
