SHUTDOWN OF THE CARONI WATER TREATMENT PLANT

The Water and Sewerage Authority (WASA) advises customers in parts of North, Central and South Trinidad, served by the **Caroni Water Treatment Plant** that there will be a disruption in their pipe borne water on **Thursday 24th July, 2025**, between the hours of **8:00 p.m. and 12: 00 midnight**.

This has become necessary in order to facilitate emergency electrical maintenance work at the facility. The affected areas include:
