SERVICE DISRUPTION TO CUSTOMERS SERVED BY THE NAVET WATER TREATMENT PLANT

The Water and Sewerage Authority (WASA) advises customers in parts of South East Trinidad, served by the Navet Water Treatment Plant that there will be an interruption in their pipe borne water supply on **Friday September 12, 2025**, between the hours of **8:00 a.m.** and **12:00 noon**

This has become necessary in order to facilitate planned mechanical repairs at the Plant.

Princes Town, Manahambre, Iere Village, Tableland, Robert Village, George Village, Liberville, San Pedro, Clearwater, Rio Claro, Deep Ravine, Mayaro, Ecclesville, Cunapo Southern Main Road, Plum Mitán, Rio Claro Tabaquite Road, Tabaquite, Williamsville, Piparo, New Grant, Hindustan, Whiteland, Hardbargain, Buen Intento, Malgretoute, Matilda, St. Julien, Indian Walk, Barrackpore, Cumuto, Borde Narve, St. Mary's Village, Moruga, Penal Rock Road.

Customers are further advised that following the completion of these works, it may take up to twenty-four (24) hours for the supply to normalize in some affected areas.
