

TRANSMISSION MAIN AT BEETHAM GARDENS REPAIRED AND FULL SERVICE RESTORED

Friday 8th May, 2026: The Water and Sewerage Authority (WASA) today confirms that repairs to the ruptured transmission main near Beetham Gardens were successfully completed at approximately 7:30 p.m. yesterday, Thursday 7th May 2026. Full service has since been restored.

The Authority extends sincere gratitude to residents and customers for their patience and understanding as emergency response teams worked diligently and efficiently to complete the repairs.

WASA also advises the public of a separate, unrelated mechanical incident that occurred this morning. At approximately 9:00 a.m. today, Booster Pump-set #3 at the Valsayn A Booster Station experienced a significant mechanical issue, rendering it inoperable.

Maintenance teams were deployed immediately and are currently on-site assessing the situation to determine the necessary repairs. The Valsayn A Booster Station requires two booster pumping units for full output, with one unit now out of service, production has been temporarily reduced by 50%.

As a result, customers in several areas, including along the Eastern Main Road, Champs Fleurs, Mt. Lambert, and Upper and Lower Santa Cruz (including the Santa Cruz Booster Station), may experience low pressure or intermittent supply.

WASA reassures the public that its truck-borne service remains active to provide relief to customers who may be adversely affected. Affected customers can access this service by calling WASA's Customer Contact Centre toll-free at 800-4420/4426.

The Authority is fully in command of the situation and assures all customers that every effort is being made to rectify this issue in the shortest possible time. Further updates will be provided as restoration efforts progress.
