EMERGENCY REPAIRS AT BRIDAL ROAD CUNUPIA CAUSES TEMPORARY SHUT-DOWN AT THE CARONI ARENA WATER TREATMENT PLANT

Friday 11th September 2026: The Water and Sewerage Authority (WASA) advises that an urgent temporary shutdown occurred at the Caroni Water Treatment Plant on Thursday 10th September at 6:00 p.m. and restarted on Friday 11th at 4:30 a.m.

This temporary shutdown became necessary to facilitate critical repair works at Bridal Road Jerningham Junction, Cunupia.
